RINGS OF ICE AND ROCK

Saturn's rings span **280,000 km** wide but are only 30 metres deep — made of billions of pieces of ice and rock, from snowflakes to chunks the size of houses.



IT WOULD FLOAT

Saturn is **less dense than water**. If you could find a bathtub big enough, Saturn would actually float on top instead of sinking. A truly fluffy planet!
